GRANT POLICY AND PROCEDURE

Introduction

The Illinois Rangers Support Foundation (the “Foundation”) anticipates that most of the contributions made to it will be used in the ministry of Royal Rangers in the State of Illinois. However, both legally and morally, the Foundation has a stewardship responsibility to ensure that all contributions are used to accomplish the Foundation’s tax-exempt purpose. To provide structure for exercising this stewardship, the following grant policy and procedure have been adopted. All grants will be made in accordance with this policy and procedure.

Grant Applications

All grant applications will be made on the form attached.

For annual funding to provide camp sponsorships or other operating subsidies, the grant application will be made by July 31st each year. Special project requests should normally also be made at the same time, though when there are special needs the request may be made at other times.

All grant applications will be circulated to the Board of Directors (“Board”) for review before its regular annual meeting. Grants will normally be considered for approval at the August Board meeting. Grants approved by the Board must be certified by the President and Treasurer before funds are disbursed.

Grant Approval

Grant approval shall be contingent on agreement by the applicant to the terms of the Grant Application and its satisfaction of reporting requirements for prior grants. Payment of all grants will be contingent on receipt of contributions. All grants require a report by each recipient to the Board on usage of the grant and the impact on the applicant at the end of the grant period.
